Driving Directions From I-45 (North or South)

- At Conroe exit SH 105 West toward Navasota
- Go West approximately 16 miles to the City of Montgomery
- At main intersection SH 105/FM 149 (traffic light), continue West through intersection
- Texaco station and Shipley's Donuts on right. Turn right immediately after donut shop onto Pond Street.
- Historic cemetery on left. The next building on left is the Historic Methodist Chapel and large, white metal building with "The Bells of Montgomery" painted on the side.

Driving Directions from FM 149 (from the South)

- At main intersection SH 105/FM 149 (traffic light), turn left (West)
- Texaco station and Shipley's Donuts on right. Turn right immediately after donut shop onto Pond Street.
- Historic cemetery on left. The next building on left is the Historic Methodist Chapel and large, white metal building with "The Bells of Montgomery" painted on the side.

Driving Directions from FM 149 (from the North)

- At main intersection SH 105/FM 149 (traffic light), turn right (West)
- Texaco station and Shipley's Donuts on right. Turn right immediately after donut shop onto Pond Street.

Parking—There is plenty of parking at or very near our facility

Some parking is allowed on the East side of our facility. We try to reserve this for the wedding party and late arriving guests.

Just across the street to the East, there are parking spaces at the rear and in front of Pecan Hill Florist. Also, there are two small lots just to the North of there in which parking is allowed on Saturday and Sunday.

North of our facility is The Old Baptist Church. There are several spaces on the North side just off Caroline Street.

There is lots of parking behind (West) our facility just off Caroline and Cemetery Streets. Park in the rocked area. If additional parking is necessary and the weather permits, guests may park on the grassy area West of the roped off area.

Please do not block driveways.
